MORE ACTIVITIES OF THE NIGHT

This year we have invited the Mayors of Centerville, Perry, and Warner Robins, the Chairman of the County Commissioners, and the Superintendent of the Board of Education to participate in a **"DUNKING BOOTH CHALLENGE"**.

This will serve as a demonstration of their support for the Family Promise mission while engaging the public. The principals have the right to name a designated representative and we are only asking for 20 minutes of their time. During their time period as many folks as would like to

can make a financial donation for the opportunity to do so. All donations toward dunking an official will count toward the final winner. Of course the winner will have bragging rights, great press, and a nice gift for their effort toward helping the homeless kids in our community. The dunking booth will begin right after our opening at 5:00 PM so you do not want to be late! It will close at official sunset (8:04 PM).

But those that just want to come out and enjoy the activities and entertainment are more than welcome to join us. We are asking these friends to give a \$10 donation each; however families that may not be able to make a larger donation will not be turned away. We want a large crowd to join us for a fun evening, helping to end homelessness one family at a time! Your donation covers the cost of food, activities, and entertainment. Participating at the dunking booth will cost extra.

★ In the event of inclement weather we will be able to move inside to the auditorium.

It was a challenge to get children to day care, school, and her job, but with a lot of effort she was making it work until the bus system was cancelled for lack of riders. Family Promise, as part of after-care support, worked with Nia and a host of staff and volunteers to help her get to her job until a generous donor made it possible to transfer ownership to Nia. She is even treating some of those volunteers who transported her to a ride!
