## Family Promise: CLUB 247

What is Club 247? An avenue of financial support for FPGHC

**Why is it needed?** 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, Family Promise provides overnight accommodations, meals, clothing, and services for parents and children who are currently without a permanent home. Our mission is to help these families regain their independence while offering services and programs that will help them meet their needs.

How can I be a part of Club 247? By donating \$2.47 (or more) per week to Family Promise of Greater Houston County. You can give weekly, monthly, quarterly, or yearly; whatever is the easiest way for you to give a total of \$128.44 for one year. Individuals, Clubs, Sunday School classes, Bible Study Groups, and others can support FPGHC in this way; making a difference in the lives of homeless children and their families in our community.



What will \$2.47 a week provide? Some examples: 1+ gallon of gasoline for our van to transport our guests each day, 5 hours of Utilities at the Day Center, 3 hours of insurance (vehicle & liability), 10 minutes of job search guidance and support for our guests, 14 size 4 diapers, 4 rolls of toilet paper, 1 bottle of shampoo, 2 toothbrushes, or 1 toothpaste.

**How do you spend \$2.47** *each day?* \$2.47 could buy a morning 'coffee shop' drink, a breakfast biscuit, a couple of donuts, or an energy drink. It's not that much is it? Would you be willing to consider giving this amount *weekly* to help our guest families?

**How to get started:** Simply send your donation to the PO Box address listed on the last page of the newsletter and write "Club 247" in the memo line. It's that easy!

The Middle Georgia Community Action Agency Staff took on the challenge and became a blessing to our Family Promise Guests!



The MGCA selects local non-profits to assist and responded to our Needs List. A huge thank you to all the MGCA staff for their generosity!


# The Reality for Working Parents

The average annual cost of childcare in the United States is \$9,589 for one child.

Two parents working full-time at federal minimum wage make \$30,160. Childcare for one child is 32% of their income.



The poverty level for a family of 3 is \$20,420. Childcare for one child accounts for 47% of that income.





Childcare in 33 states costs more than the national average of in-state college tuition.
