Perry Leadership Class of 2024 Helps Family Promise Continue Efforts for Homeless Families

An article in the January 27, 2025 edition of the Houston Home Journal shared the following information; Quoted from the article: “The Perry Leadership Class recently completed their project helping Family Promise. Every year the class chooses a community service project, said Cindy Simons, the project’s primary organizer. Family Promise needed improvements on the facility, including landscaping, heating and air conditioning and improvements in the laundry room. Simons shared their main goal was to fix their laundry facility. The class helped mow the grass, paint the laundry room and raised funds to buy a commercial grade washer and dryer. 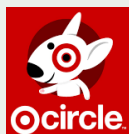
