*One of our biggest expenses is gas, up to \$140 per week. While guests are in the program we try and assist with gas to get to work if they have their own transportation. We also need gas for our 15 passenger van which makes many trips per day from churches to and from the Day Center and for guests to get to work, school, medical appointments and other transportation needs. Other needs for Walmart, Target, Visa type cards: Rx's, work clothes/shoes, oil changes/maintenance, totes, food at the Day Center,diapers, office supplies.
