Nicole Rosser, MPA Executive Director We love seeing our program expand in ways that will benefit our parents and children; which requires much more than shelter. In December we will open an Afterschool Program. This extension is long overdue, will be a

blessing to our guests, and it will allow us to serve more families.

Some of the greatest challenges our families face are:

- Support for children over the age of 12 who have aged out of daycare
- Support to families who work after daycare closes at 6 PM
- Support to families during Summer, Fall, Christmas and Spring breaks

This program will allow families to work regular hours without the concern of care placement for their children and will be at no cost to our families. While we can't meet the needs of every family, this is a great start to assist many.

Here are a few of the details and we will have more information coming soon: Children must be in the Family Promise Program to utilize services, No Cost to our families, Age Group K-12, Hours of operation: Monday—Friday, 4PM—7PM, and Hours will vary and extend during school breaks.

What parents can expect: Engaging experiences for the children, Tutoring, Social Development, Supervised and Safe Environment, Field Trips, and age appropriate Life Skills Classes.




