A mentor serves as a friend, advocate and a bridge to the community . . . someone who is available for encouragement and creative problem solving.

Some key qualities of a successful mentor include:

Empathetic	Understanding
Encouraging	Sincere
Flexible	Caring
Non-judgmental	Persistent

While the purpose of being a mentor is to encourage and assist a low-income family, you will enrich your own life. Your mentoring relationship offers very tangible benefits.

- * Using your knowledge and experience to help others
- * Personal satisfaction from making a difference in a family's life
- * Sharing your own growth with the family you mentor

A mentor is trained to offer both practical and emotional support by helping to:

- * Define goals
- * Identify community resources
- * Recognize the family's unique strength
- * Review progress and celebrate achievements

Comprehensive training and assistance is available to all mentors along the way. On average, mentors are expected to spend 1-2 hours per week with a family, once training is completed. Our training manuals have arrived and we are excited to get this program rolling.
